

# **Club Redline Code of Conduct**

## **Rules and Regulations**

1. Members shall behave in a positive social manner when attending any events organized by Club Redline. Events may require differing levels of behavior (IE language, noise levels, etc.) than other events.

2. Members shall not engage in any inappropriate vehicular operation at any time that may cause law enforcement to associate Club Redline with illegal motor vehicle activity as set out by the State of Minnesota's laws and statutes regarding automobile operation.

A) You are responsible for your own actions, and breaking the law may jeopardize your membership.

3. Members exercise respect in all of their actions while participating in any Club Redline affiliated activities.

A) Treat all members with respect.

B) Treat public and private property with respect.

C) Treat law enforcement officials with respect.

D) Treat the general public with respect.

4. Members shall listen carefully and follow any guidelines set out for any club activity.

5. Abuse of any kind will not be tolerated, and if need be a suitable consequence for any member's actions, the proper authorities will be notified without hesitation.

A) Physical abuse, sexual abuse, verbal abuse, or any other type of abuse will not be tolerated at any public or private club affiliated activity. Violation of abuse policy will be terms for immediate suspension or membership termination.

6. Consumption of alcohol at club events is forbidden if it causes any club members to participate in illegal activity. (IE drunk driving, minor consumption, alcohol transportation, etc...)

7. Any inappropriate conduct displayed at any club activity that is stated in this article, or any other inappropriate behavior deemed so by the leadership, will be considered grounds for suspension or expulsion from the club. If you are expelled or suspended from the club for any reason you will not receive any monetary refund for any purpose.

8. Website and Forum:

A) Member's are allowed only one Forum Name/Password and must register a valid email address.

Posting under secondary usernames or alias usernames other than your main account for any reason will not be tolerated. Creating a new account to replace an inactive account is forbidden. Impersonating anyone is forbidden. Members must have a valid e-mail account in profile so a forum moderator or administration can reach them if the need presents itself.

B) Post only on the appropriate forum category.

Refer to the following descriptions of each board's particular focus. Please keep your posts relevant, and refrain from posting the same information on multiple boards. Repeat offenders are subject to administrative action. "Spamming" the boards will not be tolerated under any circumstances.

C) Be courteous to other users.

Controversy is welcome as long as it is presented with civility and maturity. As per the terms of the user agreement, you agree not to post any abusive, obscene, vulgar, slanderous, hateful, threatening, and sexually-oriented or any other material that may violate any applicable laws. This includes using creative spelling to go around word filters that may be set in place. Repeat offenders are subject to administrative action. Name-calling, threats, and "flame wars" will not be tolerated under any circumstances.

D) Expect differing opinions.

If you post asking people for their feedback, be prepared to hear both positive and negative views. That is what message boards are for. If you can't stand to hear somebody say they don't like your car, don't ask what people think about it.

E) Solicitation of any kind is restricted.

No spamming or unapproved solicitation of any kind. Any such messages will be removed at the discretion of either a forum moderator or administrator. Group buy topics may be posted in the forum they most apply to. Only Club Redline Sponsors are permitted to post commercial posts but they must be made in the appropriate forum.

F) Posting of member's personal information is forbidden.

Posting of member's personal information is strongly forbidden. This can include member's home address, phone numbers, online message system information and also any personal discussions you've had with a member. If consent to post a private conversation or personal information is given, that must be presented within the message.

G) Illegal activity is discouraged.

Discussion of illegal activity is strongly discouraged on Club Redline forums or websites. Remember, the forum is a public mode of communication and ANYBODY could be reading what you post.

9. The members of Club Redline, including elected officers, shall abide by and follow the guidelines, suggestions, and processes laid out in the Constitution of Club Redline. Any effort to change the Constitution without proper amendment processes is strictly forbidden.
